



NWISL POLICY 106

SUBJECT: DIVISIONAL SCORING AND TIE BREAKERS

The following format shall be used for determining NWISL Divisional Winners. The results may be used for bracketing Teams for NWISL Tournaments.

- 1 Points
 - a) Two Points for a Win
 - b) One Point for a Tie
 - c) Zero Points for a Loss

- 2 Total points determine placement.

- 3 When total points are tied, the following tie breakers shall be used.
 - a) First tie breaker shall be head to head scoring.(Game points)
 - b) Second tie breaker shall be goals against for the season.
 - c) If Teams remain tied, a coin flip shall be used to determine bracketing for NWISL Tournament play.
 - d) If Teams remain tied for Divisional Trophy position, both teams shall receive identical trophies.
(I.e. if tied for First Place, both Teams will receive First Place trophies and no second place will be issued.)
 - e) In Divisions scheduled where some Teams play some twice, and others only once, head to head results will not be used.
Goals against shall be the determining factor.
 - f) NWISL SHALL NEVER USE GOALS FOR TO DETERMINE DIVISION PLACEMENT.
